MEDIA PROTOCOL

The media protocol has been designed to help achieve an understanding between all media and those representing British Swimming. It aims to create opportunities for the media as well as appreciate the commitments of athletes and staff. This media protocol will be utilised leading up to and during all international competitions.

The protocol recognises that everybody is present at a major competition to do a job – whether they are athletes, coaching staff or the media. Each group experiences its own pressure to deliver, however, consideration of each other's circumstances, roles and responsibilities will help ensure everybody has a successful and productive experience.

ACCESS TO THE NATIONAL PERFORMANCE DIRECTOR AND HEAD COACH DURING COMPETITION

Media requests in relation to the National Performance Director and Head Coach should go through the Head of Communications. Those wishing to put a question to the National Performance Director and Head Coach should provide as much notice as possible so the Head of Communications can identify a window of opportunity to respond. If the National Performance Director and Head Coach is unable to respond in person, the Head of Communications will pass on their views. During the competition the National Performance Director and Head Coach will only give views on the performances of British athletes and the team as a whole. Due to the demands of the job at hand, the National Performance Director and Head Coach's time will be limited so as much prior notice to any requests would be greatly appreciated.

ACCESS TO BRITISH COACHES DURING COMPETITION

After the final event of the day a coach or coaches with relevance to that evening's finals will be available to the media at a location within the venue. This will be co-ordinated through the Head of Communications. These coaches will only speak on their athlete's performance. Comments on the overall team performance will only be given by the Head Coach or National Performance Director.

ACCESS TO ATHLETES OR COACHING STAFF DURING COMPETITION

Requests for interviews with athletes or team coaching staff must go through the Head of Communications. Whereas media deadlines will always be considered, these interviews will be arranged at a time the athlete or coach can be made available. This is obviously due to the demands of the competition on time. Athletes and team coaches will only comment on their relevant performances. Overall comments will be provided by the Head Coach or National

Performance Director via the Head of Communications.

Access to athletes and coaches will be limited to the official mixed zone, press conferences or through prior arrangements made via the Head of Communications. All athletes will be encouraged to speak to the media, however, due to the need to recover by "swimming/ warming down" immediately after an event, time in the mixed zone will be limited and it is envisaged the media will collect at a good vantage point to be informed as a group rather than as individuals. The swimmers have between three to six minutes from the time they've finished their race to get to the swim down pool. Within this time there is a need to service all areas of the mixed zone - broadcast and print - fairly.

The swim down pool is off limits to all media as indicated by accreditation. No member of the British Swimming squad will be available at swim down.

The Head of Communications will try to obtain quotes from athletes if, for whatever reason, access has been limited further. These will hopefully be provided before swim-down or drug testing. If it is not possible to meet these needs then interviews may take place following warm-down. Where a swimmer has an event the next morning, there will be no post swim-down interviews that evening.

If an athlete has achieved a notable result

their specific coach will also be encouraged to make themselves available to the media at the end of the session. The Head of Communications or Team Manager will be present during interviews. The Head of Communications and Team Manager will always consider special requests made by the media.

When an athlete has finished their final event of the championships they will be free to consider additional media requests made via the Head of Communications. Efforts will be made to meet these as long as they don't impact on the rest of the team.

MEDIA NOT PRESENT AT THE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Not all media will be accredited for international events but the Head of Communications and Media team in the UK will try to look after all enquiries via phone or email. The same protocols should be followed. Athletes, staff or the Head Coach should not be contacted directly. Their time is limited and therefore the Head of Communications will arrange for information to be forwarded at a convenient moment.

British Swimming encourages the sport to be covered by all media, present or not present. However, all media should

understand that priority has to be given to those who are in attendance at the event. Efforts will be made to meet all requests and British Swimming asks that protocol be respected at all times.

MISCELLANEOUS

All media requests will be considered on their individual merits and decisions made in the best interests of British Swimming. Several requests for separate interviews at the same time will be dealt with in order of deadlines. Media with the tightest deadline will be dealt with first.

If photographers require access to members of the squad for non-action shots away from the competition then all requests should be made through the Head of Communications.

For all media interviews, athletes and staff will only wear British Swimming kit supplied for the event by the team sponsor apart from unbranded swimsuits.

All interviews will only involve representatives of the British Swimming team. No persons outside of the team will be allowed to contribute to an interview involving a British Swimming squad member.

No team member or programme-supported athlete is allowed to be part of any media team during camps or competitions, or to disclose or discuss

activities during these events.

There will be no access to athletes or coaching staff at the team hotel. It is requested that this privacy be respected.

All media enquiries should be made to the Head of Communications. If unavailable the media should approach the Team Manager. The Head of Communications and Team Manager must both be aware of all media activity.

Athletes can only talk about their own performance, coaches can only comment on athletes in their own specific group and not the overall team performance, the Head Coach can talk on the overall team and all matters. Support staff are unable to comment on performance.

SWIMMING SELECTION POLICY

1. SELECTION TRIALS

- 1.1. Selections will be made from performances at the British Gas Swimming Championships, Ponds Forge Sheffield 26-30 June 2013

2. TEAM SIZE

- 2.1. A maximum team size of 35 athletes will be selected.

3. INDIVIDUAL EVENT SELECTION

- 3.1. The first and second place finisher in the final of each Individual Olympic and Non-Olympic Event will be considered for selection provided they record a time that equals or betters the qualifying time listed in Table 1.

4. RELAY EVENT SELECTIONS

For the purposes of selection the combined times of the four athletes under consideration in 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 must equal or better the qualifying times for the relevant relay event listed in Table 1.

4x 100M FREESTYLE @ 4 x 200M FREESTYLE RELAYS

- 4.1. The 4 fastest available swimmers in the final of the 100m freestyle and 200m freestyle events will be considered for selection.

4 X 100M MEDLEY RELAY

- 4.2. The fastest available swimmer in the final of the 100m freestyle, 100m backstroke, 100m breaststroke and 100m butterfly events will be considered for selection.

RELAY ALTERNATES

- 4.3. A 5th swimmer will be considered for selection if the combined times of the 2-5th ranked swimmers from the finals equals or betters the relevant qualifying times listed in Table 1. A 6th swimmer will be considered for selection if the combined times of the 3-6th ranked swimmers from the finals equals or betters the relevant qualifying times listed in Table 1.

5. COACH SELECTIONS

- 5.1. The British Swimming Head Coach will assume the position of Head Coach.
- 5.2. A maximum of seven (7) Team Coaches will be selected at the complete discretion of the Head

Coach in consultation with the National Performance Director taking into consideration swimmer rankings, the number of swimmers the coach has on the team, staff balance and coach support of team philosophies.

OPEN WATER SELECTION POLICY

1. SELECTION TRIALS

- 1.1 Initial selections will be made from performances at the London 2012 Olympic Games Marathon Swimming Event.
- 1.2 Using British Swimming Long Course Rankings 19th June 2012 – 11th March 2013, the 3 highest ranked British males in the 1500 Freestyle and the 3 highest ranked British females in the 800 Freestyle will be selected to compete at the secondary Open Water Trials (Portuguese National 10K Champs – 18th May 2013) where the final selections for the World Open Water Championships will be made.

2. TEAM SIZE

- 2.1. There are 2 male and 2 female places available for selection in the 10km event.

3. SELECTION POINT 1

- 3.1. The fastest British male and female swimmer achieving a top 14 finish at the London 2012 Olympic Games Marathon Swimming event will be selected for the 10km event. The GB

Open Water Coach must be satisfied that the selected swimmer(s) are preparing for peak performances at the 2013 FINA World OWS Championships for their selections to be confirmed.

4. SELECTION POINT 2

- 4.1. The remaining 10km places will be filled by the fastest male(s) and fastest female(s) at the secondary Open Water Trials.
- 4.2. Places in the 5km event will be offered to swimmers who have qualified for the 10km event.

5. COACH SELECTIONS

- 5.1. The Head Coach will be appointed by the GB Open Water Coach.
- 5.2. Coaches will be selected at the complete discretion of the GB Open Water Coach in consultation with the National Performance Director taking into consideration swimmer rankings, the number of swimmers the coach has on the team, staff balance and coach support of team philosophies.

DIVING SELECTION POLICY

OVERVIEW

This document is intended to provide transparency on those factors that make up the selection process for Diving for 2013 for the **European Championships Rostock, Germany 18-23 June 2013** and for the **FINA World Championships Barcelona, Spain 20 – 28 July 2013**.

RATIONALE

Diving is an extremely subjective sport and thus there will be a significant component of subjective decision making in regard to the final selection of the team. Final selection is at the sole discretion of the National Performance Director ("NPD").

This policy is a qualifying document but please be aware of and understand the following:

1. On meeting the Selection Criteria, divers are only Eligible for Consideration for Selection. The final team selection will be at the sole discretion of the NPD.
2. All selected team members are required to sign and comply with the British Swimming Code of Conduct.
3. Any diver or coach who withdraws from the team following selection may be liable to the Federation for the reimbursement of any costs incurred.

REQUIREMENTS

In all cases, it is a pre-condition of selection that ALL athletes complete a British Swimming Medical Declaration Form and that any athlete requiring a TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption) shall have obtained the necessary certification prior to travel.

There are no exceptions and any diver failing to follow these requirements will NOT be permitted to travel with the team to the relevant meet.

APPEALS

All appeals of decisions of nomination to the BS Diving Team will be dealt with under the British Swimming Team Selection Appeals Procedure. Details are available from the British Swimming Legal Affairs Department if required. Athletes should be aware of the time limits contained in the Procedures, which are designed with the intention of resolving issues expeditiously and fairly.

OBJECTIVES

To select athletes that will form the team to achieve the best possible results. To select athletes that have the potential to succeed at future events. To employ a transparent and fair selection process that provides all athletes a chance to challenge for team selection

QUALIFICATION STANDARDS

The Qualification Standards below are taken and based on the London Olympic Games 2012 results, using the 18th place score from the prelims and the 12th place from the semi-finals and then rounded up according to the forecast score.

The minimum Qualification Standards required to be eligible for consideration for selection are:

EVENTS

The following events will be used for selection, subject always to the NPD's sole discretion:-

1. Assessment Camp - 18th-21st December 2012, Southend-on-Sea
2. British Gas National Championships - 8th-10th February 2013, Plymouth
3. FINA Grand Prix 2013 competitions
4. FINA World Series 2013 competitions
5. European Championships - 18th-23rd June 2013

The British Gas National Championships in Plymouth will act as the main selection event for both the World Championships 2013 and the European Championships 2013.

The NPD has identified the FINA World Series Competitions 2013 and the FINA Grand Prix Competitions 2013 for athlete performance monitoring in the build up to the FINA World Championships 2013 and the European Championships 2013. The NPD will use these competitions to assist his decision making and exercise of his discretion, however, performances at these Competitions will only be used as a guide. The NPD will select the athletes at his sole discretion.

SELECTION FOR:

**The 3rd Arena Diving European Championships
Rostock, Germany
18-23 June 2013**

The 3rd Arena Diving European Championships is the second major event of the 2013 season following the World Championships.

There will be two phases of selection for this event:

Phase 1 - British Gas National Championships 8th – 10th February 2013 - Plymouth.

The winner of the individual events will be

selected, subject to achieving the Qualifying Standards and subject to NPD discretion.

The second place divers for individual events, synchronised couples and the pair for the team event will be selected by the NPD at his sole discretion in accordance with Phase 2.

Phase 2 - Within 2 working days from the conclusion of the last leg of the FINA World Series (26th May 2013) the NPD will announce the team selected for the European Championships 2013 based on the National Championships 2013 results (4 individual events winners subject to them achieving the Qualifying Standards) plus the second place individual divers and synchronised pairs based on the FINA World Series and FINA Grand Prix. Selection is at the sole discretion of the NPD.

For 1m events for the European Championships 2013 - divers will be selected by the NPD in his sole discretion from within the team already selected for the European Championships 2013 to compete in the 1m event, unless a diver competing in the 1m final at the European Championships 2012, that has already been selected to the European Championships 2013 team, achieved a Qualifying Standard taken from the top 3rd score from the final of the European Championships 2012 and then rounded up. These are set out below:

Men's 1m	405
Women's 1m	280

SELECTION FOR: The 15th FINA World Championships Barcelona, Spain 20-28 July 2013

The 15th FINA World Championships is the major competition of the year in 2013 for British Diving. There will be two phases of selection for this event:

Phase 1

British Gas National Championships
8th – 10th February 2013 in Plymouth.

The winner of the individual events will be selected, subject to achieving the Qualifying Standards and subject to NPD discretion.

The second place divers for individual events, synchronised couples and the pair for the team event will be selected by the NPD at his sole discretion.

Phase 2

Within 2 working days from the conclusion of the European Championships 2013 (23rd June 2013) the NPD will announce the team selected for the World Championships 2013 based on the National Championships 2013 results (4 individual events winners subject to the divers achieving the Qualifying Standards) and the European Championships 2013 results, plus the second place individual divers and synchronised pairs based on the FINA World Series 2013 and FINA Grand Prix 2013. Selection is subject to the NPD's sole discretion.

For 1m events for the World Championships 2013 - divers will be selected by the NPD in his sole discretion from within the team already selected for the World Championships to compete in the 1m event, unless a diver competing in the 1m competition at the European Championships 2013 wins a medal in which case the medallist will be automatically selected to compete in the 1m event at the World Championships.

General:

Selection will be conditional on signing and complying with all British Swimming provisions consisting of:

- British Swimming Doping Control Rules and Protocols
- Selection Agreement and Code of Conduct
- British Swimming Disciplinary Code
- ASA Child Protection Procedures

The NPD will exercise his authority to ensure that the final selections for the World Championships 2013 and the European Championships 2013 Diving team are in line with this Policy with a view to achieving the Objectives set out at the beginning of the Policy.

Athletes must demonstrate an uncompromised commitment to training preparation for peak performance at the World Championships 2013 and the European Championships 2013 as determined by the NPD. If for any reason the athlete is unable or unwilling to fulfil this

commitment, they may be withdrawn from the team at the complete discretion of the NPD.

Athletes will be expected to attend each programmed event, where selected, taking part in all programmed activities. Unless otherwise agreed, no athlete will be allowed to leave a camp or undertake any activities that are not directly relevant to the camp programme, this includes any external media or social activities.

Athletes becoming unfit due to illness or injury at anytime following selection of the team must notify British Diving immediately and will be required to undertake a full medical examination (by an independent medical advisor approved by British Swimming Medical Staff), which may result in the athlete being de-selected from the team at the discretion of the NPD.

This document supersedes any previous Selection Policy or Procedure in relation to the FINA World Championships 2013 and European Championships 2013 - 31st January 2013.

WATER POLO SELECTION POLICY

This document is intended to provide transparency as to those factors which make up the selection process for the 2013 World Championships. The multi-faceted nature of team sport make objective criteria very difficult to define, and thus there will be a significant component of subjective decision making in regard to final selection of squads.

1. OBJECTIVES

- 1.1. To select athletes that will form the senior women's team that have the best chance of success at the World Championships 2013 and beyond, leading towards 2016 Olympics.
- 1.2. To employ a transparent and fair selection process that provides all athletes a chance to challenge for team selection.

2. SELECTION PANEL

The selection panel's primary function is to meet the objectives set out above. The selection panel will consist of the Head Coach, Assistant Coach and the Performance Director and will be chaired by the Performance Director. The panel will consider feedback provided from any other staff member that it is deemed appropriate to aid the decision making process. The Chairman's selection or de-selection decision is final.

The selection panel retains the right to select or deselect any athlete dependant on injury, form or loss of form, and/or any disciplinary issues that may affect the athlete or the team's performance. The selection panel's selection or de-selection decision made by way of the Chairman is final.

3. SELECTION AREAS

Water Polo is a team sport and it is difficult to base selection strictly on athletic performance. Acknowledgement is made that in selecting for a team sport, combinations of athletes, the balance of a squad and the ability of athletes to play in more than one position together with development potential are also considered alongside individual skill level. The areas set out below are those agreed by the Performance Director and Head Coach as fundamental to selection for the British Women's Water Polo Team.

The selection panel will draw information on Accuracy, Consistency and Improvement of the individual athlete in relation to the following factors:

- 3.1. Competition
 - 3.1.1 Consideration of performance and personal contribution to the team in all British Swimming camps and competitions leading into the World Championships and in club competitions during 2012/13.
- 3.2. Physiological Requirements
 - 3.2.1 General Physical Fitness
 - 3.2.2 Results of swim testing, speed and speed endurance tests
 - 3.2.3 Results of S&C specific testing, max strength and strength endurance tests
 - 3.2.4 Water polo swimming general and water polo specific fitness
 - 3.2.5 Leg movement, strength and speed
 - 3.2.6 Wrestling strength
 - 3.2.7 General and specific dry land strength
- 3.3. Technical ability
 - 3.3.1 Swimming technique
 - 3.3.2 Leg work technique
 - 3.3.3 Ball skills – passing, swimming with ball, shooting
 - 3.3.4 Movement – with/without ball
- 3.4. Tactical ability
 - 3.4.1 Understanding and ability to put into practice individual tactics for their position
 - 3.4.2 Understanding and ability to put into practice team tactic
 - 3.4.3 Game awareness
- 3.5. Compatibility with coaches and other athletes
 - 3.5.1 Individually contributes to enhance team dynamics
 - 3.5.2 Appreciates each team member
 - 3.5.3 Fits in to the balance of the team
 - 3.5.4 Takes advice from staff to enhance performance
 - 3.5.5 Gels with other team members.
- 3.6. Psychological abilities
 - 3.6.1 Mental Toughness - ability to maintain and highlight optimum performance under pressure and adversity.
 - 3.6.2 Focus and Concentration - ability to maintain performance related focus and good work ethic for the duration of all training and competition sessions.
 - 3.6.3 Demonstration of an internal drive and motivation towards excelling as an individual and within a team environment for team success
 - 3.6.4 Confidence in own ability to correct and adapt at competition
 - 3.6.5 Commitment to the programme, to the team, and to themselves
 - 3.6.6 Taking ownership and responsibility

- 3.6.7 Attitude – a positive attitude to staff and players, an energy giver
- 3.6.8 Pride and passion in representing their country as team member
- 3.6.9 A team player that is open minded and plays to his/her strengths
- 3.6.10 Positive decision making under pressure

- 3.7 Additional Factors
- 3.7.1 Positional selection – the balance of players playing in certain required positions.
- 3.7.2 Players that play effectively in more than one position
- 3.7.3 Proven experience of game play in competitions

4. CONDITIONS OF SELECTION

- 4.1. Selection will be conditional on signing and complying with the British Swimming Code of Conduct. Athletes must also comply with all British Swimming:-
 - British Swimming Doping Control Rules and Protocols
 - Selection Agreement and Code of Conduct
 - British Swimming Disciplinary Code
 - ASA Child Protection Procedures

- 4.2 All team members will be expected to abide by the Media Protocols of the British Water Polo Programme.

- 6.2 Athletes must demonstrate an uncompromised commitment to training preparation for peak performance at the World Championships 2013 as determined by the Head Coaches. If for any reason the athlete is unable or unwilling to fulfill this commitment, they may be withdrawn from the team at the complete discretion of the respective Head Coach.

- 4.3. Athletes will be expected to attend each programmed event, where selected, taking part in all programmed activities. Unless otherwise agreed, no athlete will be allowed to leave a camp or undertake any activities that are not directly relevant to the camp programme, this includes any external media or social activities.

- 4.4. Athletes becoming unfit due to illness or injury at anytime between selection to the squad on 10th June 2013 and the nomination of the team to FINA must notify the respective Head Coach immediately and will be required to undertake a full medical examination (by an independent medical advisor approved by British Swimming Medical Staff), which may result in

the athlete being de-selected from the team at the discretion of the respective Performance Director.

5. GENERAL

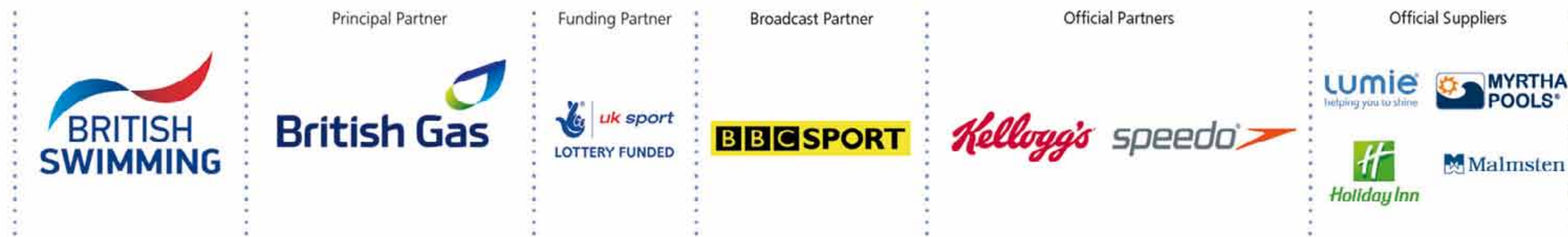
- 5.1. The Head Coaches will exercise their authority to ensure that the final nominations for the World Championships Games 2013 Water Polo Team are in line with this policy with a view to achieving the objectives set out at the beginning of this policy.

- 5.2. All appeals on the nomination (or non-nomination) to the GB Women's World Championships Water Polo 2013 Team under this policy shall be dealt with under the British Swimming Team Selection Appeals Procedure. Details are available from the British Swimming Legal Affairs Department on email – legal@swimming.org. Athletes should be aware of the time limits contained in the procedures, which are designed with the intention of resolving issues expeditiously and fairly.
